At the same time, EQ School largely avoids presenting ready-made truths. Instead, the reader is invited to reflect through images, symbolism, and concrete exercises. The project does not merely

wish to teach—it wishes to develop people's ability to think for themselves, giving the material an unusual warmth.

Graphically, the concept is beautifully supported. **The illustrations involving the child, the balloon, the roots, and the lighthouse create a red thread** throughout the entire universe and make complex thoughts easier to grasp.
